The camp is designed for children with speech and language difficulties, including children with phonological disorders, articulation difficulties and language delays. Children will be grouped by age and therapy needs. (ages 3-6)

Designed for students with difficulties in oral language, auditory processing, problem solving, reading and/or writing, this camp offers opportunities for students to learn new skills and strategies in fun, thematic-based activities. The students will participate in individual sessions to target their specific needs, as well as group sessions to integrate newly-learned skills in other activities with their peers. Students will be grouped by age and therapy needs. (ages 5-11)

**Tech PALS** provides opportunities for school-age children with social language difficulties to interact with peers. Designed for individuals with language disorders, learning disabilities, or autism/PDD, this camp offers many opportunities for children to develop valuable social language skills, including those needed for play, conversation, non-verbal communication, perspective taking, and humor. Children will learn skills in individual sessions and then use those skills in group activities. Children will be grouped by age and therapy needs. (ages 5-11)

**Listen Up Club and Camp Listen to Learn** are designed to help school-aged children, with auditory processing disorders or hearing loss, to develop self advocacy, implement compensatory strategies, and improve auditory processing skills.
