Food Assistance:

- **YWCA of Lubbock**
 - Grab and Go Lunches available for anyone under 18 years of age
 - Served Mon-Fri from 11:00 to 1:00 at the YWCA Sun 'N Fun from the concession stand window on the pool patio.
- **Catholic Charities, Diocese of Lubbock**
 - Food voucher walk-ins: Wednesdays and Fridays from 1:00 PM - 3:30 PM
- **Lubbock Meals on Wheels**
 - Starting Monday, March 23, volunteers will pick up and drop off coolers using the drive-through
 - Volunteers that are delivering routes 1 – 31 are asked to arrive between 10:45 AM – 11:00 AM
 - Volunteers that are delivering routes 32 – 63 are asked to arrive between 11:00 AM – 11:15 AM
- **Salvation Army**
 - Dining room closed. Take-away meals being provided at regular meal times.
- **South Plains Food Bank**
 - Working with other community stakeholders to ensure food security for children, seniors, and others affected by the health crisis. More information will be posted as it becomes available.
- **Lubbock ISD -- Curbside Pickup and School Bus Distribution**

Beginning Monday, March 23, curbside pickup will be available at 16 Lubbock ISD campuses Monday through Friday, from 12 - 1:30 p.m.

 - Curbside Meals – A few important guidelines and location information can be found in [this flyer](#).
 - School Bus Distribution – beginning on Monday, March 23, with 20 buses delivering food across the city of Lubbock. Routes will begin at 12 p.m. and run until 1:30 p.m. in order of their regular stops. The bus numbers have not changed from their regular routes, so students who normally ride the bus will be familiar with the bus numbers. Childcare Options:

Gov. Abbott's March 19 executive order does not apply to daycare centers. At this time, all daycare centers may remain open with the following measures:

- Health checks on all children outside of the building including having their temperatures taken.
- Drop off and pick up will be at the door of the facility.
- Parents who want to go to the classroom will also have their temperature taken as will all staff.

The YWCA of Lubbock has extended our camp services to offer care to anyone who has been impacted by the school district closures. Hours of care will be from 7:30am to 6:00pm. The YWCA is a licensed CCS provider and we are following the guidelines set forth by Child Care Licensing, the CDC and the American Academy of Pediatrics.
